After reading the text, write ...

◆ New animal enclosure

Draw an enclosure (pen) for tigers or lions at the zoo. Remember lions like open space but need somewhere to go for "quiet time".

Tigers like lots of trees and places to hide. You can also invent some clever activities in the enclosure for your lions or tigers. Write labels on your picture. Have fun!

◆ Big cats

Sort the lions from the tigers. Follow the instructions on Work Sheet 5.

◆ Your big cat poster

Make a lion or tiger poster of your own. Choose some pictures from Work Sheet 5. Place them on a sheet of A3 paper and glue them.

Write some describing words about the animal on strips of card. Do this in big fancy writing using marker pens.
